

Release Notes – AFClient 3.5.0 for Windows

October 8, 2025

Scope

The purpose of this document is to provide an update summary for AFClient Virtual Printer 3.5.0. This document is mainly targeted toward users choosing to upgrade from 2.0.x, 2.1.x, 3.1.x, 3.2.0, 3.3.0, 3.4.0 to 3.5.0 or for users new to AFClient. The main focus of this release is to allow users to attach evidence documents to an arbitration filing or subrogation demand. This release will also allow users to upload multiple documents from Windows Explorer and provide a dashboard to monitor the status of sent documents.

System Requirements

Operating Systems Supported

- Microsoft Windows Server 2008 R2 (64-bit)*
- Microsoft Windows 10 (64-bit)*
- Microsoft Windows 11 (64-bit)*

Note: Support for Windows XP, Vista, Windows 7 and Server 2003 has been dropped.

In addition to the requirements for running any of the above operating systems, AFClient 3.5.0 also requires the .NET Framework 4.8* to be installed. If you choose to install AFScan, we assume you have a working scanner that supports the TWAIN API (TWAIN driver installation required by user).

*AFClient 3.5.0 may run on the higher versions of operating systems and .NET frameworks. However, no testing was performed to validate its operation on higher versions.

Known Issues

Silent Install/Uninstall

Silent install/uninstall may not notify the installer that installation/uninstallation has failed. Please examine the log files to determine the cause. AF recommends that the silent install/uninstall scripts be tested in a test environment first before rolling them out company-wide.

The “Untrusted publisher” dialog box appears when you install a driver in Windows Server 2008 R2. To avoid receiving the “Untrusted Publisher” dialog box during installation, the following Microsoft hotfix should be applied: <http://support.microsoft.com/en-us/kb/2921916>.
